

Modern slavery statement for financial year 2022/2023

This statement is made pursuant to s.54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and sets out the steps that Arrandene MFG has taken and is continuing to take to ensure that modern slavery or human trafficking is not taking place within our business or supply chain.

Modern slavery encompasses slavery, servitude, human trafficking and forced labour. We are committed to acting ethically and with integrity and transparency in all business dealings and to putting effective systems and controls in place to safeguard against any form of modern slavery taking place within the business or our supply chain.

Our business

Arrandene MFG is a metal trading company which has evolved from a long-standing family history in the ferrous and non-ferrous metal industries. We operate all over the world with subsidiary companies in the USA and China.

At Arrandene MFG we have always placed a strong emphasis on integrity and close customer relations and have become a major supplier to the steel, aluminium and copper industries.

Our high risk areas

The areas of the business that we consider to be high risk are the first stages of the supply chain (production of raw materials and collection of scrap metal), and it is thus difficult to assure that the extraction and original production and collection of materials is done responsibly.

Our policies

We work closely with our suppliers and audit them regularly to ensure the quality of the products we supply and compliance with current legislation. Arrandene MFG will stop trading with any supplier at the suspicion that any form of forced labour is taking place until corrective action is taken.
